Dear Parishioners in Christ Jesus! Greetings to you from Fr. James. JD

As per the Provincial announcement yesterday (January 7th) we will continue with drive in/drive through Masses until the restrictions on in person faith gatherings are lifted. Kindly note the following for your information.

- Weekday Masses will continue to be Drive-in only. This means if you wish to attend Mass and receive communion during the week you must come before Mass and park in the parish parking lot for the entire duration of Mass. You cannot enter the parking lot after the mass begins. Entry and exit points must be followed strictly please do not enter where it is posted "Do Not Enter"! Please call the office to register!
- Until further notice, Sundays will have one drive in/ drive through Mass at II:00am; this Mass will also be livestreamed. A maximum of 50 cars are allowed per Mass. There can be more than one attendee per vehicle, provided they are from the same household. Kindly reserve your place with the Parish office by phone or email (you will receive a confirmation email), registration will be taken in the order that they are received.
- Only on Sundays, drive through 'Communion' is permitted, this means that those parishioners participating in "livestream Masses from the Parish at Home" can drive to the parish and receive communion by driving in front of the church. You may leave your home to drive to the church after Fr. James invites you to communion with the words:

"Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world..." and you respond: "Lord I am not worthy... but only say the words and my soul shall be healed."

- For audio of the Holy Mass kindly tune in your radio (FM) in the car to the frequency 107.1
 FM or, if on Sunday, stream the Mass off YouTube on your device. People must stay in their cars always. Wear extra sweaters and warm socks so that you are prepared for the weather.
 Remember, you will be in your vehicle for the whole duration of the Mass.
- Please follow the COVID Safety plan when receiving communion. Remember to wear your mask and only remove it to receive the Blessed Sacrament. Sanitize your hands before receiving communion!

While thanking every one of you for your continued support and encouragement throughout these difficult times, I really implore you to avail the above possibilities deepen your faith and community life. Please call me if you need any clarifications.
